Cheaper Childcare

Families right across our community will have access to cheaper child care.

Port Kennedy recently received a community battery, one of 400 across Australia.

More older Australians can now access the Commonwealth Seniors Health Care Card thanks to new laws passed by the Albanese Labor Government.

The annual income thresholds will rise to \$90,000 for singles and \$144,000 for couples.

The CSHC is available to Australian residents or special category visa holders who have reached aged pension or veteran pension age and do not already receive income supports through a social security pension or benefit, or veterans service pension due to their income.
